An overriding theme is the work of the Holy Spirit, which played a prominent role in Jesus' ministry, and will now empower the church and guide its witness in the 1st century. Gripping incidents and vivid characters, from the dramatic punishment of Ananias and Sapphira (5:1-11) to the speech of Paul before King Agrippa (26:2-23) to Paul's later adventure on the high seas (27:1-44), make Acts inviting to read and to study together.
